Parents are reminded that there is no student supervision at the school prior to 8:00 am and no student supervision after the buses have left.

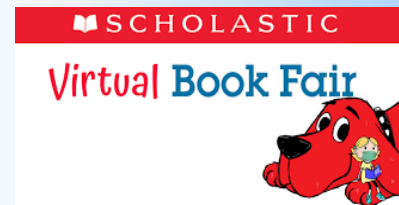


Book Fair

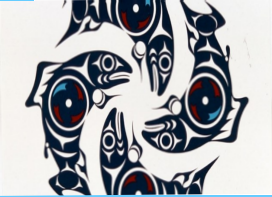
