**Changing Weather:** Please remember to dress for the changing weather, especially with our mornings becoming colder! Students are expected to have a warm coat, gloves, a hat and proper footwear. 

## REMINDER

**When bus runs are cancelled in the morning, they will be cancelled for the duration of the day. There will be no buses running that afternoon. Teachers will be in attendance at schools.**

## **School District Transportation Bus Safety & Rules**

### **Students:**

- Use your bus pass to scan on and off the bus.
- Remain seated while the bus is in motion.
- Keep your hands, feet, head, hats, backpacks, etc. inside the bus and to your self at all times.
- Place your trash in the bins provided at the front and rear of the bus.

### **Parents/Caregivers:**

- If your student has misplaced their pass, please contact us and we will print a new pass.
- Students need to be registered for the buses they are riding.
- If your student is taking a bus other than the one they are registered for (to go to a friends house for example) please contact us and we will notify the bus driver about the approved change.

RE: Important Reminder Regarding Bus Cancellations and Student Transportation

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Dear Parents and Guardians,

As we move into the winter season, we would like to remind families of the procedures School District 28 follows regarding school bus cancellations. Please review the information below to ensure that you are prepared should service disruptions occur.

➤ **Check for updates**

Parents and students are responsible for checking official district communication channels for any bus cancellations. Notifications are posted on:

- The SD28 Website
- The SD28 Transportation Facebook Page

*Please note: The district is unable to make individual phone calls regarding bus cancellations.*

➤ **Types of cancellations**

- **Cold Weather Cancellation:** Quesnel schools remain open, but all school buses are cancelled for the entire day.
- **Individual Bus Cancellation:** A specific bus (e.g. bus XX) is cancelled for the entire day.

➤ **Individual Bus Cancellation Details**

If a bus is cancelled in the morning:

- It remains cancelled for the entire day.
- Families need to be aware of their assigned bus numbers for both morning and afternoon routes, including transfers.
- There is no replacement bus, including for transfer students.
- Students may only ride the bus they are registered on. They cannot switch to another bus.
- If you drive your child to school, please ensure you can pick them up after school.

➤ **Cold Weather Preparedness**

We ask that all students be dressed appropriately for winter conditions, including:

- Warm coats
- Winter boots or sturdy footwear
- Hats, mittens/gloves, and layers

While buses are heated, delays or emergencies are always possible. Proper winter clothing is essential for student safety.

Thank you for your cooperation and support in ensuring safe and consistent transportation for all students.

### Every Day Counts

1 or 2 days a week doesn't seem like much but ...

If your child misses ...	That equals...	Which is...	And over 13 years of schooling that's...
1 day every 2 weeks	20 days per year	4 weeks per year	Nearly 1.5 years of learning
1 day per week	40 days per year	8 weeks per year	Over 2.5 years of learning
2 days per week	80 days per year	16 weeks per year	Over 5 years of learning
3 days per week	120 days per year	24 weeks per year	Nearly 8 years of learning

It is important to contact the school in the event:

- your student will be absent or late
- if a different person will be picking up your child at the end of the day
- if your phone number changes

We ask that parents/guardians contact the office no later than 2:00 pm to relay messages to students in a timely manner. Any changes can also be put in their planner as a reminder. Thank you.
